Energy resting places Centre - Gleisdorf

Take the chance to visit one out of thirteen municipalities of the “1st International Energy Road of Europe”, settled in Eastern Styria. At these places one thing is shown exemplarily, how energy can be generated from nature, without endangering thereby resources or the environment. The operators of these sites united to a working group (“ARGE Energy Road”). All together they want to emphasize interested people to use solar energy and vegetable oil and to make these technologies more understandable.

- solar tree
- height 17.3 metres
- 140 photovoltaic elements
- annual proceeds: 6.6 MWh for communal road lightings

Street of solar energy

- 3.5 kilometres through the city centre with 80 “solar facilities” to visit
- operational buildings of “Feistritzwerke“
- sun wheel in front of school (“Hauptschule I“)
- sun clock in front of the city hall (Rathaus)
- low-energy houses “SUNDAYS“
